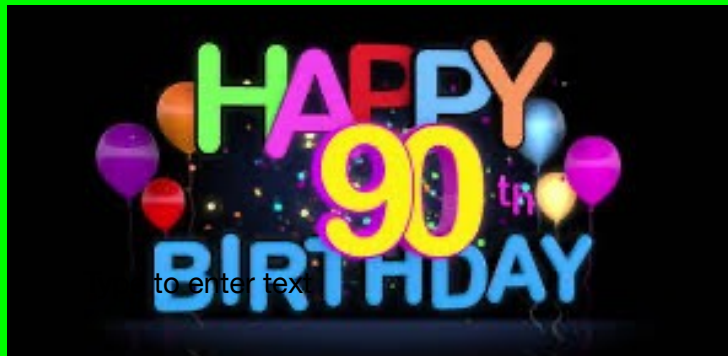




PRESIDENTS REPORT
